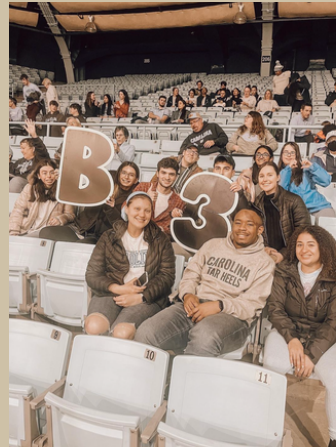


February

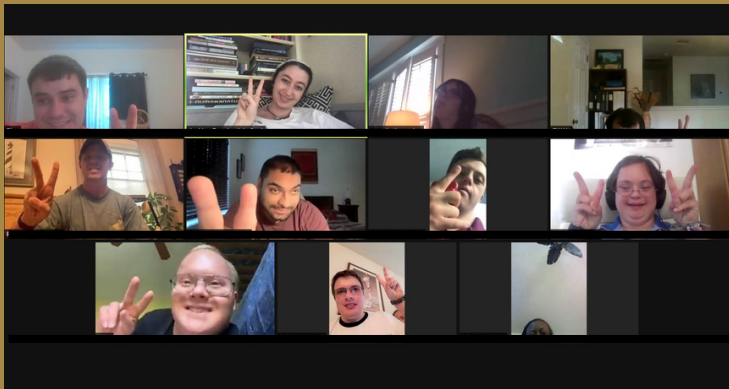

The kiosk is operated by paid interns who either identify as allies to the disability community or as people with lived experience of disability. This aligns with our no hierarchy model between people with/without disabilities, which is critical to advancing disability justice. All interns receive training in self advocacy, work readiness, and/or allyship.
